

HIV in Slovenia

- Prevalence estimate <1 person/1000
- Most cases seen in men who have sex in men (2/3 of all cases)
- Cca 50% late diagnoses (<350 CD4/mm³), half of which concurrent HIV and aids diagnoses

HIV testing in Slovenia

- Low rate of people tested for HIV (1.6 1.8 /100)
- Easy access to free, anonymous or confidential HIV test in healthcare settings
- But stigma and lack of awareness prevent access to testing for most atrisk persons





Community-based testing in Slovenia


- National HIV Strategy 2017-2025 stipulates provision of community-based testing for men who have sex with men
- CBVCT currently provided only by one organisation Legebitra
- Funded by the government and the city of Ljubljana
- Testing in most Slovenian regions
- Partnership with the Institute of Microbiology and Immunology, Faculty of Medicine, and cooperation with the Department of Infectious Diseases, Ljubljana University Medical Centre

- Oral and rectal gonorrhea






Who we test for...

- *Hepatitis B* all unvaccinated (+ aHBs titer post-vaccination)
- Hepatitis C all
- Syphilis all without prior diagnosis
- Oral and rectal gonorrhea all






Testing process

Co-funded by the Health Programme of the European Union


When and where...

- Once per week in Ljubljana
- Once per month in Maribor
- Once every 3 to 4 months in other towns
- Once per month in each of the two gay saunas
- Clients can pick up results in person (twice a week) or by phone






Number of clients 2009-2018

| HIV | 1258 | 11 | 0,87% |
|---------------------|------|----|-------|
| Syphilis | 1157 | 41 | 3,50% |
| Gonorrhea | 2024 | 58 | 2,90% |
| Hepatitis B (HBsAg) | 495 | 2 | 0,40% |
| Hepatitis C | 1270 | 1 | 0,10% |
